



ASIAQ Mobility grants

During the entire ASIAQ project duration 2018 - 2020, mobility of researchers – especially of early career scientists - will be encouraged. Researchers from any ASIAQ-partner university can apply for these mobility grants for:

- short term visits of individual researchers at ASIAQ-partner universities and other universities in the partner countries; participation in Arctic Science Workshops if they take place in a different country than the applicants’;
- short term visits of ASIAQ members to attend important other strategic workshops (such as e.g. IASC planning workshops);
- short term visits of individual researchers (early career) to attend PhD courses or summer schools at ASIAQ partner universities;
- short term visits of individual senior researchers to lecture at PhD courses or summer schools at ASIAQ partner universities;
- short term visits of selected project members to draft and finalize a “white paper” on the Arctic Science Integration Quest.

Applications must contain:

- ✓ CV with publications (maximum four pages, Times New Roman, 12pt)
- ✓ Information about research colleague to visit (“host”) and/or seminar/workshop to attend, including dates and a description of planned activities (“research program”) during the visit (maximum 3 pages, Times New Roman, 12 pt)
- ✓ A confirmation of the host
- ✓ Budget

Applications will be evaluated continuously during the project period; expected handling time is 4-8 weeks.
