



ASIAQ Mobility grants

June 2019

During the ASIAQ project duration 2018 - 2020, mobility of researchers is encouraged. Researchers from any ASIAQ-partner university can apply for mobility grants for short term visits of:

- individual researchers at ASIAQ-partner universities and other universities in the partner countries, in order to
 - conduct joint field work involving at least two ASIAQ partners;
 - jointly prepare (at least two ASIAQ partners contributing) ASIAQ outreach activities;
 - participate in Arctic Science Workshops;
 - other activities well motivated and interlinked with ASIAQs overarching goals, but not stated above;
- ASIAQ members to attend other strategic and relevant workshops;
- early career researchers to attend PhD courses at ASIAQ partner universities;
- senior staff to lecture at PhD courses/summer schools at ASIAQ partner universities;
- selected project members to work on publications documenting ASIAQ efforts.

Applications must contain:

- ✓ CV with publications (maximum four pages, Times New Roman, 12pt)
- ✓ Information about research colleague to visit ("host") and/or seminar/workshop to attend, including dates and a description of planned activities ("research program") during the visit (maximum 3 pages, Times New Roman, 12 pt)
- ✓ A confirmation of the host
- ✓ Budget

Applications will be evaluated continuously during the project period; expected handling time is 4-8 weeks.
